

2006 Desert German Shorthaired Pointer Club Awards Application

The purpose of DGSPC's annual awards is to honor members who, with their dogs, have won AKC titles. The following policy will be reviewed every three years.

- I. Qualifications for an award:
 - A. Applicant must be a DGSPC member in good standing at the time of completion of the requirement for the title that the award is for.
 - B. Applicant must be the owner of the dog or a member of the immediate family or household of the owner.
 - C. Applicant must have trained and shown the dog in earning the title being applied for.
 - D. An applicant must have earned an AKC title to receive the original plaque at no charge.

- II. One plaque will be awarded per dog. Plaques are wooden and display the DGSPC logo. A metal plate engraved with the dog's registered name and breed on the plaque. Title name and the date earned will be engraved on a metal plate, and affixed to wooden bars that hang from the plaque. A separate bar will be awarded for each title.

- III. All applications for performance title awards (AKC or other) must be accompanied by a copy of the title awarding organization's certificate of acknowledgement of the title. If certificate has not been received, a list of shows or tests in which the dog received credits for the title, must be sent.

- IV. All non-AKC awards will have the awarding organizations initials appear before the title. Example: NADAC, USDAA, ASCA, APDT, etc.

- V. After the initial plaque has been obtained, in accordance with I-A through D, the applicant can then apply for additional bars at no charge recognizing the following AKC titles: obedience, rally, tracking, field, hunting, herding, lure coursing, earthdog, agility and breed championship.

- VI. The AKC Canine Good Citizen Title, therapy dog and any other non-AKC titles including UKC obedience titles do not qualify for a no charge plaque or bar. A plaque can be obtained for these titles at a charge of \$15.00 per plaque. Bars may be purchased for \$5.00 each.

- VII. Additional bars for titles listed in V or VI above that were earned prior to becoming a member of DGSPC, or any foreign obedience title, foreign breed champion, foreign agility, foreign field/hunt title, drafting, temperament of Canine Good Citizen can be purchased for \$5.00 each
